The report of the Working Group was circulated to all banks by RBI vide their circular and covering letter dated 29-4-2011. This Seminar focuses mainly on areas like Internet Banking, IS Security, IS Audit, Cyber Crime etc addressed in this report.

**Shri M. Narendra**, Chairman and Managing Director of Indian Overseas Bank will deliver the inaugural address. **Shri G Gopalakrishna**, Executive Director of RBI, the Chairman of the Working Group has kindly consented to deliver the key-note address in the seminar.

**Who should attend?** Middle and senior level officers of banks from I.T. Dept, Inspection, I.S. Audit, Vigilance and HR; those officers from IT and other allied software organisations engaged in development or testing or implementation of banking applications and those tech-savvy individuals who are avid users of e-mail, internet and other electronic gadgets. No deeper knowledge of any particular software is required. A user-level awareness of operating systems, browsers and common technical terms on banking will suffice.
